She has exhibited her work throughout the Asia-Pacific region including Bus Projects, Port Jackson Press, McClelland Gallery & Sculpture Park, Kyoto Municipal Museum of Art, Iy in Australia and abroad and worked as a scientific, courtand the Tokyo National Art Centre.

Her work is held in collections at RMIT, Sydney College of Arts, Architecture and the colours of the earth inspire much of his State Library of Queensland and the National Gallery of Australia, and numerous private collections in Australia, Finland, Netherlands, New Zealand, United Kingdom, United States, familiar, yet strikingly unique. 

## ALONG THE RIVER DAMON & KYOKO

"Along The River" is a collaborative suite of 14 etchings and an accompanying zine [small magazine]. The prints and zine are based on drawings by Damon Kowarsky of the riverside architecture of Kyoto, Japan, with artistic interventions by Kyoko Imazu.

The drawings of Kyoto were made during research trips to Japan by the artists in 2011 and 2013. Much of their work investigates cultural exchange between two Australian artists, one of Japanese and the other of European background.

The drawings by Damon of the riverside architecture of Kyoto are the basis for interventions by Kyoko. These interventions contrast Damon's views as a visitor to Japan with Kyoko's insights as a Japanese citizen and a permanent resident of Australia.

Printmaking has a long history as a 'democratic' medium. By producing both ephemeral and exclusive objects Damon and Kyoko hope to reach the broadest possible audience.


